

<u>Independent Accountant's Report</u> <u>on Applying Agreed-Upon Procedures</u>

We have performed the procedures enumerated below, which were agreed to by the Board of Directors of East Montgomery County Improvement District (the "District"), on the invoices and schedules submitted by Global Earthquest Ventures, LP (the "Developer") for payment from proceeds of the District's Series 2009 bonds. These procedures were performed solely to assist you in evaluating the reasonableness of those costs, and the report is not to be used for any other purpose.

This agreed-upon procedures engagement was conducted in accordance with attestation standards established by the American Institute of Certified Public Accountants. The sufficiency of the procedures is solely the responsibility of the Board of Directors of the District. Consequently, we make no representation regarding the sufficiency of the procedures either for the purpose for which this report has been requested or for any other purpose. The procedures performed are summarized as follows:

- A. We reviewed the use of proceeds schedule as prepared by the District's Financial Advisor for the bond issue. Our review was for the purpose of identifying those items authorized for District participation by the agreement and those items the District is specifically prohibited from purchasing.
- B. We reviewed for completeness certain Developer schedules, supporting invoices and contract estimates in substantiation of the costs to be reimbursed. Our review included all documentation supporting items, amounts and categories for which reimbursement is requested.
- C. We met with management to discuss the reimbursement, and amounts to be reimbursed in accordance with the agreement.

- D. We read the development and financing agreements for particular items that might affect the reimbursement. The agreements reviewed are referenced in our report.
- E. We reviewed payments with check copies and compared them to contract amounts submitted for consultants, and reviewed detail for expenses they submitted. We received confirmations from banks on the major contracts.
- F. A draft of this report was provided to the District's Attorney, Engineer, Financial Advisor, Bookkeeper, and Developer for their review and comments.
- G. We prepared this agreed-upon procedures report for the benefit of the District, which includes the Accountant's Report, schedule of amounts reimbursable to the Developer and a schedule summarizing the costs to be funded from the bond proceeds by category.

The attached Schedule A titled "Schedule of Project Development Costs Reimbursable to Global Earthquest Ventures, LP (Developer)," sets forth their reimbursable costs. A Memorandum of Understanding was executed on February 22, 2008 by and among the District, the For Profit (FP) entity and the Not for Profit (NFP) entity. This reimbursement is in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Agreement Regarding FP Pre-Development Expenses dated May 1, 2008 between Global Earthquest Ventures, LP and the District. On October 13, 2008, an Amended and Restated Agreement Regarding FP Pre-Development Expenses was executed between the District and the Developer.

Global Earthquest Ventures, LP originally submitted invoices for reimbursement in the amount of \$3,479,520.69, plus a payroll and overhead allocation of \$420,719.02. Subsequently, additional overhead amounts were submitted in the amount of \$89,695.42, bringing the total submitted to \$3,989,935.13. We have revised the schedule to a total reimbursable amount of \$3,314,485.60.

The following changes have been made to the Developer's original schedule:

- A. We corrected the overhead invoice due to a typing error, resulting in an increase of \$1,000.
- B. We corrected a FedEx expense for a decrease in the amount of \$35.09.
- C. We deducted \$650,000 for an advance made by Global Earthquest Ventures, LP for pre-development expenses in accordance with their agreement which is not reimbursable.

- D. We deducted \$15,000 for a golf tournament sponsorship which is not reimbursable as a pre-development cost.
- E. The amount reimbursable for payroll and overhead allocations was limited in the agreement to \$500,000. We deducted \$11,414.44 in accordance with that limitation.

The attached Schedule B reflects the amount of bond proceeds received, the amount being spent to date by category and the projected costs to be funded in the future.

We were not engaged to and did not conduct an audit, the objective of which would be the expression of an opinion on the aforementioned reimbursable costs. Accordingly, we do not express such an opinion. Had we performed additional procedures other matters might have come to our attention that would have been reported to you.

This report is intended solely for the information and use of the Board of Directors and is not intended to be and should not be used by anyone other than this specified party. However, this report is a matter of public record and its distribution is not limited. This report should not be associated with the presentation of any financial data of the District except to comply with filing requirements as specified by the agreements.
