10	majority of creditors that do not speak or understand English or our judicial system including
11 12	Debtor's president, and some staff. The language barrier and complexities became significantly
13	more difficult under the strain management experienced from months of personal and business
14	attacks, efforts to obtain law enforcement assistance and bankruptcy proceedings. More time than
15	initially anticipated was spent serving as an intermediary between Debtor's counsel re-explaining
16 17	and clarifying the basic bankruptcy process to Debtor and interacting with Debtor counsel at
18	management's insistence. Many of our lifelong citizens have difficulty understanding and are
19	afraid when involved with our impressive court system and laws. Debtor's management and staff
20	were terrified because of their own or family members experiences with court proceedings in
21	other countries.
22	other countries.
23	7. Prior to the bankruptcy I provided a variety of corporate counsel services. In addition to
24 25	general business services I provided counsel during months of anonymous attacks on social media
26	forums, defamatory calls and emails to law enforcement and regulatory authorities, threats to
27	customers and contract parties and major hacking attacks on Debtor's servers. The previous

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attacks especially on the servers made it difficult preparing and providing an accurate list of
creditors and amounts owed to bankruptcy counsel and ultimately the court. The Debtor's had a
complex operations and accounting system with some information only in Russian. Between the
servers, debtor files and accounting procedures, information on each creditor (some creditors had
multiple accounts), all activities and transactions were recorded. The servers and platform system
were designed to produce a variety of reports. Unfortunately, the hacking attacks destroyed and/or
corrupted information on the servers which hampered the accountants ability to complete financial
reports and required hours and hours of manual confirmation and corrections to those reports in
order to provide creditor contact information and amounts owed to debtor's counsel.
Time was spent clarifying for Debtor exactly what information they needed to extract and verify
for each creditor and the business to comply with the Bankruptcy Code. The multidimensional
nature of the distribution platform and payment system required combining and confirming
information on over six thousand creditors, multiple promoter accounts, millions of transactions,
multiple currencies, four banks and several international payment services. Additional time was
spent working with Debtor and Debtor's counsel to address the court filing and notice system
inability to process the Cyrillic alphabet and getting important information translated.
